

FROM JAN BERNARD--TOURNAMENTS

Guidelines for Improving Pace of Play

- 1. Play Ready Golf!! Forget about Honors; if you are ready to hit and it is safe, go ahead and hit!!!
- 2. Do all your pre-shot routine while others are hitting their shot, as long as you do not distract them.
- 3. Line up your putt while others are doing the same, then be ready to putt when it's your turn.
- 4. Limit your practice swings to no more than 2.
- 5. Park your Cart or Pull Cart behind the green between the hole and the next tee, rather than leaving it in front so the group behind doesn't have to wait for you to walk back to your cart and then move out of the way before hitting!
- 6. If you are putting out and the hole ahead is open, go right to the next tee and tee off while the rest of your group finishes putting out. No need for all 4 of you to watch the last 2 people putt out.
- 7. When sharing a cart, drop one person off to hit their shot then drive to your shot and hit yours. Then pick the person back up as they walk down the fairway.
- 8. If a player is having trouble getting out of a bunker offer to rake the bunker while he goes on to hit his next shot.
- 9. Wait to mark your scorecard until you are in the cart and driving to the next tee. Discuss scores at the next tee rather than on the green.
- 10. If players behind you are ready to hit, carry your clubs to the cart, hold on to them, drive to your next shot and then put them into your golf bag.
- 11.Lost Ball Guideline: If you are having trouble finding your ball, the rule is 3 minutes; If the hole in front is open, consider letting the group behind play through while you look and then keep up with them.*
- 12. Report to the 1st tee on time so you can tee off and keep up with the group in front, right from the start.

*LOCAL RULE

USGA rules allow a player to hit a provisional ball if the player thinks the ball may be lost or out of bounds. The player may decide not to hit a provisional and, if the ball is lost or out of bounds, return to the original spot and hit again, taking a one-stroke penalty.

To speed up play, USGA created a local rule, which SSGC has adopted. This rule applies only if the player has not hit a provisional and the ball is not in a hazard.

Drop your ball either in the fairway within two club lengths nearest where your ball is reasonably assumed lost or out of bounds or drop your ball within two club lengths nearest the point where it can be reasonably assumed the ball was lost or out of bounds. Take a two-stroke penalty.

Are You Eligible for Sepulveda Seniors' Golf ClubMajor Events

Please check our club eligibility for major events: the Founders' Cup, President's Cup, Club Championship. As stated, you must have participated in at least six events since the last playing of that event a year earlier. You also must be a full member. Sorry, associate members are not eligible. To determine if you are eligible, look at our website showing Club Indexes for the current month. If your Club Index is written in black, you are eligible at this time. If your Club Index is blue, you have played in fewer than six events. This quick check can help you to determine if you need to participate in current month events to become eligible.. For more specific information, check with our Tournament Directors for each tournament.

The first major, the President's Cup, will begin in March. At this time of transition, the Directors are Don Kihara and Harvey Goldsmith. See Don's piece below regarding registering in this match play individual event.

In the beginning, we will start using it to run the tournaments and post results; the results themselves will be the same, but the look will be slightly different. 
